



## VOCATIONAL TRAINING FOR STUDENTS (ONLINE)

**When Schools have been completely closed due to COVID-19 lockdowns, we have started providing Vocational Skills Training virtually to the Children and Adolescents from extreme marginalized background.**

- Skill Training imparted on Mobile Repairing, Jewellery Designing, Beauty & Wellness to the Children and Adolescents from the marginalized background.
- Conducted Mental Health Counselling to the students to keep their Mental Well Being in place during pandemic.
- Conducted Career Aspiration Building sessions to build the motivation of the children to sow the seeds of Ambition and Leadership qualities in them so that they will be determined to create a dignified, brighter and healthier future for them.

**During COVID-19 Pandemic, the Livelihood of the rural marginalised people has been tremendously affected due to joblessness, migration from different geography etc. We have started training on mushroom cultivation and providing market linkages to the women beneficiaries from rural Bengal so that they can be self-sufficient and produce mushrooms at their home to earn money by selling it or for self-consumption among family members for good nutrition.**

- Women have been trained about mushroom cultivation, harvesting and technologies regarding this matter.
- All women have been provided with spawn, substrate and other essentials which are required for mushroom cultivation.
- Apart from training on mushroom cultivation various sessions have been organised on building entrepreneurial skills, confidence level etc.

We have done research and development work on agriculture, vertical farming, pisciculture, integrated farming, nutri-garden for the livelihood development of small and marginalised farmers. A organic vegetable garden has been developed by the local farmers on salty soil which is a challenge in the area.

Also we have distributed & planted trees, vegetable seeds to the local marginalized farmers.




### Nilima Mondal

She is a 56 years old and a housewife from Bagirulha village under Minakhan block in North 24 Parganas District. During first wave of COVID 19 pandemic her husband lost his regular work and started suffering financially. Then we selected her in our Skills & Livelihood programme for training of mushroom cultivation. then after successful completion of the programme when she started cultivating oyster mushroom at her home we bought all the mushroom from her through our partner network and she started earning. Also she gained confidence through the sessions of our programme and now she is able to earn to run her family.

### Amit Kumar Sengupta

He is 60+ years old retired professional who stays alone at his home as his both of the daughters are married and are staying outside city for their professional bindings. During 1st wave of COVID 19 pandemic when the elderly people were the most vulnerable. We started our social service under the name of "ElderMate" for the elderly people who are staying alone and unable to go outside due to lockdown. We have delivered him all the essentials, gave him companion through a phone call for his mental well-being also we have supported him by providing medical support whenever required. He found a ray of hope through us when most of the people were suffering in depression.



### Kalipada Mondal

He is a 64 years old daily wager and marginalized farmer. During the COVID 19 pandemic he lost work during the month-long lockdown and was suffering from hunger and joblessness. We provided him dry ration for 3 months for his family and also provided him with vegetable seeds and organic compost to start farming in his small piece of land beside his house. He started growing vegetables which helped him to feed his family as well as to sell the excess production in the locality to earn the basic wages for running his family.






